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Village of Callaway Proposed Bond Initiative

November 8, 2022

“Shall the Village of Callaway, NE issue bonds of said Village in the principal amount not to exceed Four Million Dollars (\$4,000,000) for the purpose of construction and equipping a swimming pool and related improvements on land owned by the Village; said bonds to bear interest at rate or rates to be determined by the Chairperson and Village Board of the Village and to become due at such time or times as may be fixed by the Chairperson and Village Board, and” “Shall the Village of Callaway, NE, cause to be levied and collected annually a special levy of taxes against all the taxable property on the Village sufficient in rate and amount to pay the interest on and principal of said bonds as the same become due?”

VILLAGE OF CALLAWAY NOVEMBER 8, 2022 LB 840 PLAN

Shall the Village of Callaway establish an Economic Development Plan as summarized below. This Plan would be funded by the Village generating a local option sales tax of 1%, estimated to generate \$40,000.00 per year

for a period of 10 years for an estimated total of \$400,000.00.

Summary of Economic Development Plan: The purpose and goals of the proposed economic development program is to create and retain jobs and generate employment opportunities within the area labor market; to attract new capital investment to the community; to broaden the tax base; and to provide economic diversification to ensure economic stability and vitality for the Village of Callaway and the surrounding area. Eligible activities under Callaway’s Economic Development Plan shall include any project or program for the purpose of providing direct or indirect financial assistance to a qualifying business or defined community goal and the payment of related costs and expenses.

Under the program, qualifying businesses will be eligible for grants, technical and marketing assistance, relocation expenses, program will be funded by a proposed local options sales tax of one percent. Upon approval; equity investment, loans, and loan guarantees, job training and by voters, the tax will remain in effect for ten years beginning April 1, 2025 through March 31, 2035, other forms of assistance for the operation and expansion of businesses as provided by law.

VILLAGE OF CALLAWAY NOVEMBER 8, 2022 SALES TAX

“Shall the governing body of Callaway, Nebraska impose a sales and use tax in the amount of one percent (1%) upon the same transactions within the Village of Callaway on which the State of Nebraska is authorized to impose a sales and use tax, for a ten year period from April 1, 2025 through March 31, 2035, to fund the Callaway Economic Development Plan (to receive an estimated \$40,000.00 each year) with the balance of any remaining sales and use tax funds to be used for all lawful municipal purposes, including, but not limited to community improvement projects.”
