BOND ELECTION
CITY OF SARGENT, NEBRASKA
TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 5, 2024
"Shall the City of Sargent, Nebraska (the "City") Issue its bonds in a principal amount not to exceed Four Million Dollars (\$4,000,000) for the purpose of financing the costs of constructing and equipping a new municipal swimming pool and related facilities within the City; said bonds to be issued from time to time, to be sold at such prices, to bear interest at such rates, to become due at such times, and to have such other terms and provisions, all as may be fixed and determined by the Mayor and Council of the City; and

"Shall the City cause to be levied and collected annually a special levy of taxes against all the taxable property in the City sufficient in rate and amount to pay the interest, principal and premium on said bonds as the same become due?"

Cliff Township Levy
"Shall Cliff Township, Custer County, Nebraska be allowed to levy a property tax not to exceed the .08 cents per 100 dollars of taxable valuation in excess of the limits prescribed by law (and to increase the restricted funds based by 66% over the allowable growth percentage) from the fiscal year 2025-2026 through the fiscal year 2030-2031. For the purpose of general operations and maintenance of roads."
