MINUTES OF THE CUSTER CO. BOARD OF SUPERVISOR

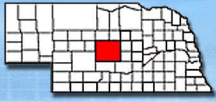
July 26, 2022

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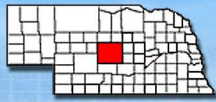

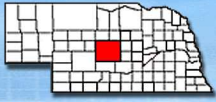

E. Haynes, Veterans Officer – presented/reviewed his Annual Report for the Veterans Office, 7-1-21 to 6-30-22, also reviewing his FY22-23 Budget.

Dan Blowers and Tony Eggleston from Arnold Township Board were present to discuss/request an Extension on their Disaster Loan #2. Their FEMA/NEMA money has been approved, but they have not received any of it yet, the three years is nearing and they should have money by end of year. They would like to request a year extension.

The Time clock quotes were reviewed and no decisions were made.

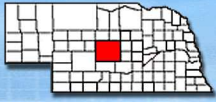
N. Olson, Asst. Hwy Supt reviewed a Federally Funded Bridge project SE of Comstock.

Motion by Longmore, 2nd Olson, to go into Executive session to discuss pending litigation, it being necessary for the protection of the public interest, or needless injury to the reputation of an individual, for the purpose of discussing strategy regarding pending litigation.
