It shall be reviewed and approved at next Board meeting. T. Walz, also presented the Annual 2022 Extension report for Custer County, to be filed in the Co. Clerk's office.

Chris Jacobsen, Hwy Supt and Nick Olson, Assistant, presented, reviewed, and answered numerous questions on the plan. Projects past and future were heavily discussed.

Numerous concerned citizens with spokesman of S. Trout and K. Hansel, were present on the Ryno Road restoration, requesting it be paved again or at least all one consistency because now it's variations of gravel, paved, mud, ground and is very dangerous if you do not know the road. R. Peterson, also spoke on the Westerville road conditions.
