If installed by the State, after five years the County would then own all the equipment. Quotes of \$74,000 and \$55,000 were presented, but with Custer County being pretty new courts-the cost would not be this high. The Co. Board would like for the State to come and talk with them and get the exact installation costs for the County.

S. Ross from CNEDD presented the paperwork on two CDBG loans.

Motion by Blowers, 2nd Gibbons, to approve an application for CPPD, to go overhead with three phase primary line, S25&30,T16,R25. (Lincoln Co to Custer Co.-Co Line Road)Roll call vote. Ayes-all

Chairman Fox read the following resolution:

The Highway Dept-Chris, Nick, Angel, were present to discuss the time clock plus signing in and county road employees. Employees do not want to use their own phones for sign in and so a cell phone package was discussed. Motion by Gibbons, 2nd Parliament to table until more information is gathered and come back to next regular board meeting Roll call vote. Ayes-all

Co. Sheriff Osmond, reported to the Co. Board of a prior prisoner that is waiting for trial and this jail cannot handle him until his trial, it will be at least \$100.00 a day plus medicines, so jail budget may be expended. The Co. Board assured Osmond it would be covered.

Anne Gibbons reported on the Custer County website and under the history tab corrections needed made. Motion by Gibbons, 2nd Kleebe, to have Tammy Hendricksen work and clean up this history tab. Roll call vote. Ayes-all
