James Biesinger, Safety & Incident Mgt.-AEGIZ-AIM, made a presentation on danger alerts, panic alerts, working with the Courthouse and Sheriff's office. An annual one-year subscription @10 cents per square ft, and it would provide training, maps and guidance and set up. No decision at this time.

Doug Nibbe, Family Heritage Supplement was present to inform the Co. Board and request permission to meet with employees of Custer County. Motion by Longmore, 2nd Kleeb, to give permission for Family Heritage representative to offer supplement to Custer County employees. Roll call vote. Ayes-all

Clerk Gracey informed the Co. Board that no bids were received for Budget preparation. The Board directed the Clerk to talk to HR repr. and put on Indeed. They also would check with several individuals that prepare budgets.

Co. Attorney Bowers and the Co. Board discussed in detail the next five Opioid Settlements and action that needs completed by April 18th. The first two settlements were opted to the Behavioral Health region, and now Teva, Allergan, CVS, Walgreens, and Walmart need to be decided if Custer County is going to participate.

Motion by Longmore, 2nd Parliament, to sign and submit the Participation Forms for Teva, Allergan, CVS, Walgreens, and Walmart Opioid Settlements. Roll call vote. Ayes-all

D. Bryner and B. Fox, showed the plans for the front steps, sidewalk, and basement entrance that will be put out for bids if the Co. Board approves.
