Miller & Assoc. and Nick Olson, Assistant Hwy Supt., read and reviewed the Change Order #1 on the Arnold River Road. After much discussion on milling, subgrade, hot mix and associated costs, the Co. Board direct Kevin Peterson of Miller & Associates to get back to the Co. Board with a different change order on milling/asphalt costs.

Adam Watkins, from Fidlar Technologies and Christie Trumbull, Reg of Deeds, presented and reviewed a software program for Register of Deeds, for land records management. The Co. Board directed them to get more figures on the revenue side.

Conard Sutton and maybe 30 other concerned citizens discussed the Sargent Road across to Victoria Springs, the traffic, speeding, drugs, traffic ruining their County Road. Sheriff Osmond was also present, numerous ideas and suggestions were gathered and the Co. Board is going to see what can possibly be done.
