J. Sennett, Att. And Wes Roberts were present to discuss the Conservation Easement Application for the Revocable Trust Agreement of Gary D Roberts. Sennett and Co. Attorney Bowers discussed the purchaser not being present and they requested the application being tabled. Motion by Parliament, 2nd Markham, to table the Conservation Easement application until the next regular board meeting.

Mark Rempe, Emg. Mgt. reviewed the Agent for North Central PET region, reviewed that the 20 counties involved have budgeted money for Grant and Custer County would have all funds before anything issued.

Motion by Longmore, 2nd Kleeb, to appoint Mark Rempe, Emg. Mgt. as Fiscal Agent for North Central PET Region for two(2) years. Roll call vote. Ayes-all

T. Walz, Ext. Agent, presented and reviewed the proposed FY25-26 Ext. Office Budget, no raise included.

Becky Dailey -SORC – reported on a sign that they would like to put on private property two miles west of Arnold and NDOT is telling them they need an application filled out and signed by the County because we have jurisdiction in that area. The board supported the project and feels the sign should show ownership by SORC, and they directed Bowers and Tibbs to help with the paperwork requiring county input.

E. Taylor, reporting from the Safety Comm. concern for liability signs in the north parking lot because many people use this lot. The Co. Board agreed to get two/three signs stating not responsible for any accidents. Taylor also reported on the AED not working, battery packs and machine are outdated. They will apply through the NIRMA Assist grant funds to see if we can get it replaced.
